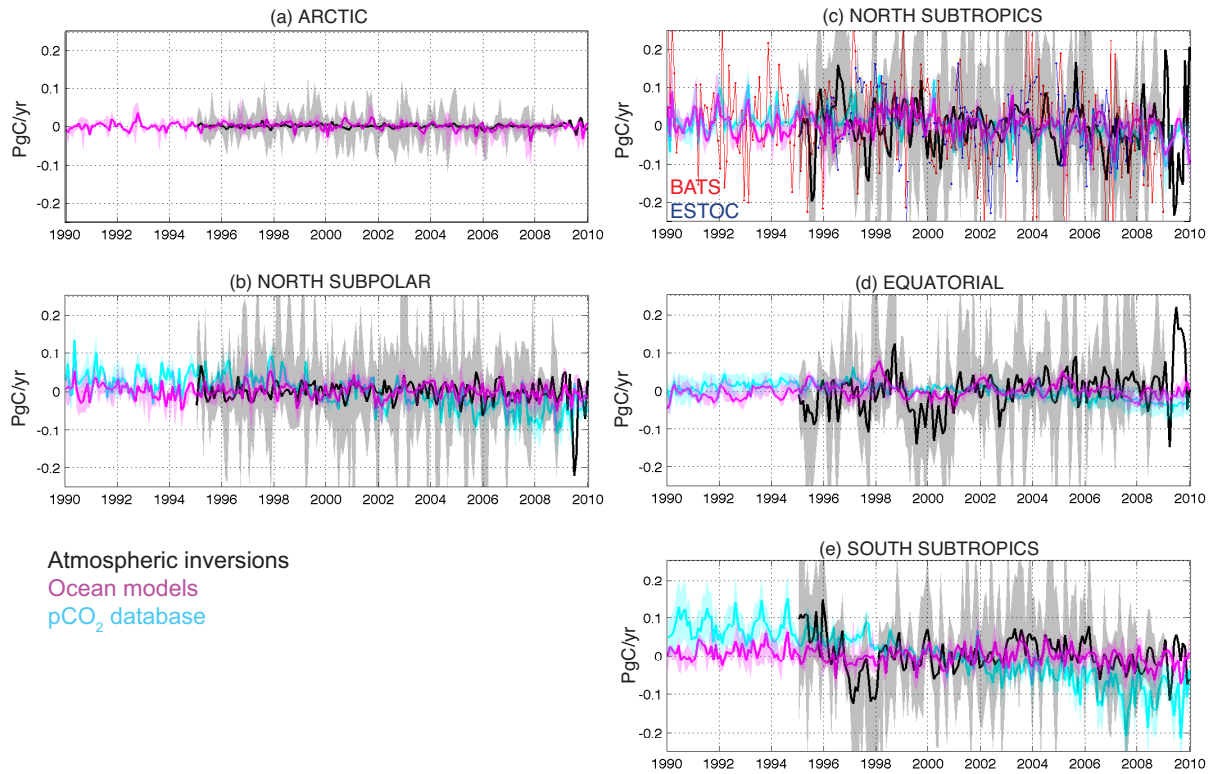


Figure Suppl 1: High frequency interannual variability of sea-air CO₂ fluxes [Pg C yr⁻¹] in the (a) Arctic, (b) North Subpolar, (c) North Subtropics, (d) Equatorial, and (e) South Subtropics for atmospheric inversions (black), ocean models (magenta), and pCO₂ database (cyan). Shaded region is the max and min from the atmospheric inversions and ocean models, and the uncertainty of the harmonic fit for the pCO₂ database. SOCAT MPR is not included because its timescale is too short. IAV at BATS (red) and ESTOC (dark blue) are included in the North Subtropics.
