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5. In line with Rev 2's first specific comment, we have clarified that the use of opaque chambers only measures dark Reco. We have incorporated their suggestion to point out that diurnal variations need to be included to ascertain Reco fully. 6. In line with Rev 2's second specific comment, we briefly commented on the likelihood and the chamber technique may have severed roots thus reducing Ra, and have incorporated one of the suggested references.
