4830:first paragraph - There the authors state that since only 2 species were found in M15 the presence of the research facilities and helicopter platform do not have any obvious effect on species richness. Can you draw that conclusion? comparing M15 to the closest quadrats there are fewer species in M15 than any of its neighbours.

4856: - in the figure text to Fig. 7 colony is misspelled.

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
