Section 2960: Abstract: line 1. The visibility of life forms in the fossil record; I would look for another word other than visibility;. How about occurrence; or preservation;? Section 2960: Abstract: line 9. ;could provide an interesting methodological alternative;. I would look for another word here instead of interesting;. How about essential; or useful;? Section 2963 (and elsewhere): line 1. I am afraid that my latin is not so good and that I could not find the term ;in saxo; in my Latin or English dictionaries. Does it mean ;in

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rock? Section 2964: 2.1.2 Belemnites: line 24. I would put commas after rostrum and guard; the rostrum, or guard, that helped to maintain;. Section 2972: I noticed that you did not reference Roemer, 1840 as the author of the species *Isselocrinus buchii* (Roemer, 1840) (line 6 under crinoids), but did reference Barnes 1985 as the author of the subfamily Pithanodelphininae Barnes 1985. Is this consistent with the guidelines for referencing in BG? Section 2976: line 7. ;grooves and riches; I believe this should read ;ridges;. Section 2976: line 21. ;what the destiny of the hydrogen;. I would use an alternative word to ;destiny;. Perhaps ;fate;? Not an easy one as I am not sure the concepts of ;fate; nor ;destiny; should be part of Science; #61514;

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
