Still, I am not yet convinced, that the "conundrum" that the authors mention really exists, when taking into account the current knowledge about the ocean biogeochemal system as a a whole and its role as the interface between input and output to other Earth system reservoirs. The combination of the Urey reactions with the organic carbon terms is, of course, a nice idea.
