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Response Letter

We thank the referees for their constructive suggestions. We respond to each comment (italics) in the attached pdf file.

The advice by the two referees helped us to make the study more comprehensive, while we preserve our initial idea of a crisp paper that is very clear about the major trends so that it is understandable and of practical use for a large audience (cf. comments referee 1). Extra analyses are presented as supplementary material, so that researchers looking for deeper understanding are not neglected. Moreover, we now specify that the applied model is free for use to maximise practicability. We could put it up on a site of Biogeosciences if possible, or alternatively, host it at another
