(2019b)), ecosystem functioning and susceptibility to damage following anthropogenic perturbation and / or resource removal (Vanreusel et al. (2016); Jones et al. (2017)).

Comment 5: funny wording, suggested change: *values; all but one are above 0.7, which...* (Line 323/333)

Line 332-333: significantly (see Figure 7 (h)). This increase is similarly reflected by the Cohen's kappa values that are all but one above 0.7, which is deemed as "substantial agreement" (0.6-0.8).
