

Interactive comment on “Soil Greenhouse Gas Emissions under Different Land-Use Types in Savanna Ecosystems of Kenya” by Sheila Wachiye et al.

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I want so suggest some changes for that publication:

N₂O fluxes are sometimes given in $\mu\text{g N}_2\text{O-N m}^{-2} \text{ h}^{-1}$ (e.g. l. 295 or 420) and in some graphics they are given in N₂O ($\mu\text{g m}^{-2} \text{ h}^{-1}$) (e.g. figure 4 or figure 5). This is the same for CO₂. Units should be used consistent, so that you can compare the fluxes. l. 171: Height a.s.l. is only given for the cropland site and should be given as well for the other sites.
