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The forcing of El Niño is a combination of the annual cycle and the tidal cycles. 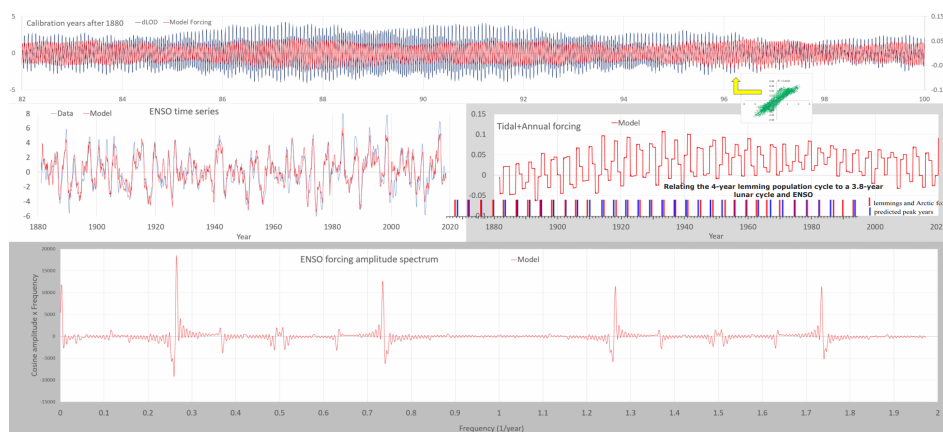


Fig. 1.

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
